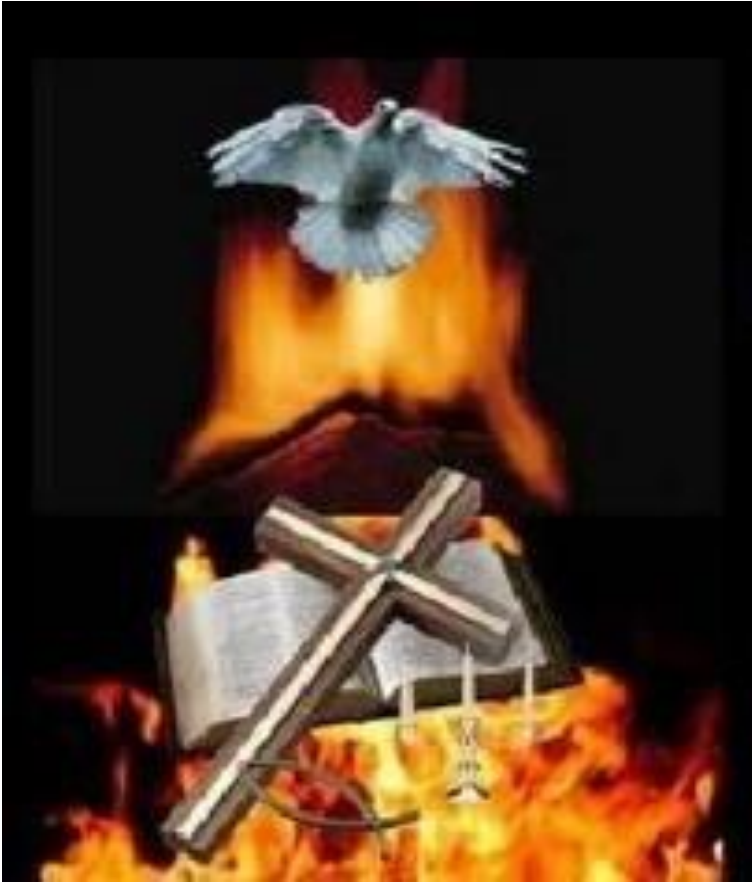

Chapter II

Chapter III

Beloved, this is what Jesus was doing in the garden suffering in great agony he was birthing the church because the scriptures state in many places

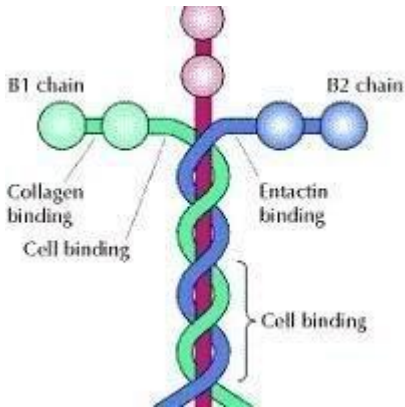
that Christ was slain before the foundation of the world.

Beloved, this cell structure and other things in nature that remind us of the cross lets us know how important we are to God. I am reminded of Balaam the wicked prophet that was warned of God not to curse Israel and even though he went with the King as a

prophet for hire he could not curse what God had blessed.

Dear reader bear with me and imagine the view of what he must have saw as God had the tribes pitch their tents in a certain formation.

Now imagine the setting if viewed from a distant hillside? Beloved, it would resemble the form of a cross. Yes what a God!

As we go further in this study we are going to discover a lot more but just think about it, when Adam sinned in the garden it did not catch God off guard for he had a plan to become man's savior.

Every time he walked with Adam in the garden he knew he would fall and every time he looked at him he could see the cross like cell structure holding his body together.

It is like the stern Judge Jesus spoke of in his parable that never gave anyone a break however one day his own mother (the Church) was brought before him and she was caught in the very act of committing a crime.

The Judge found her guilty and sentenced her to the full extent that the law would allow then with tears, got up from his bench and removed his robe. Chapter IV

The Model Prayer

Matthew 6:9-13

We find the Lord in this chapter instructing His disciples concerning the proper way to pray and approach God? Some people refer to this passage of scripture in Matthew as the “Lord's prayer.”

Here we find the preacher of all preachers standing overlooking the Sea of Galilee instructing His disciples concerning the right way to pray and approach God. He instructed his disciples to take their prayer life serious and not exploit themselves like the heathen who love to pray in public and be known for their educated words but enter into their closet and pray in secret. He encouraged them that their Father who sees in secret would reward them openly.

The Lord Jesus began His prayer by addressing God as Our Father. It was not uncommon for Kings in the Middle East to be addressed or called the Father of their people. History reveals that many times George Washington was called the Father of America.

Jesus delegated this Authority given unto Him by the Father to His church which is His body.

We as His children need to realize the Authority delegated unto us and direct our prayers asking God to mold us to become one unified body doing His will even as it is already being done in Heaven.

When we pray the words *“Hallowed be Thy Name”*, we enter into a new level of respect for God and reverence for his person.

We are giving into to His will and call upon our life by placing him on the throne of our heart even as He sits on his throne in heaven.

We are expressing unto Him that we have a burning desire for our lives to reveal His love and His character to a lost and hurting world.

We do this in our everyday life both in private and in public which is played out by our actions!

Dear reader, when we pray this prayer, we come to the place where we are not asking Him to change His will or even bless our will but we are asking Him to bring us to discover His will for our life and cause us to walk in the fullness of it.

Once we discover His will and purpose for our life, we need to show forth an effort to do it with all our might. This will show Him that we are maturing in our new walk and that we are in total submission to Him as stated in *Romans 12 verse 2* which calls for us to submit to the good and acceptable will of God which is our reasonable service. We will discover later in this study that he had a plan for life before creation and he allowed us to make the egg and become a person because we have a divine purpose for being here.

Prayer helps us to enter in and develop a relationship with Him which will allow His Spirit that is armed with His plans for our life to start His work of regeneration in us.

A devoted prayer life will help us understand, discover and follow the vision trusted to us. His purpose is what will help us get through the many tests and trials

because we are spirit beings being blessed to have a human mortal experience that we might know what it is like to love and be loved, to hold and be held; most of all to experience the reality of just how dangerous sin is especially when left unchecked.

Prayer is our blessing to both reverence Him and to receive our assignments to be a useful vessel in His hands that He might use us to leave His signature through us to future generations.

Chapter V

God Our Model Father

God expresses in *Psalms 68* of His Holy word that He is a Father to the Fatherless. Some like myself bear the memory of a rough childhood with an abusive

father who showed very little love toward his family. I never got to hear the words "Son, I am proud of you."

My Earthly Father was always telling me "I would never amount to nothing," and acted as if he was in competition with me". Dear reader, it took me years to discover our Heavenly Father desires to develop a loving relationship with us and clearly shows in His word the true characteristics of what a real Father should be.

God's word declares that he possesses a Fathers Heart, A Fathers Love, A Fathers Strength and A Fathers Concern for His people. God desires for us to maintain a family relationship with Him and even though he already knows our needs, he wants us to come like a child climbing upon His father's knee trusting and believing that He is able and desires to meet all of them.

Because we are members of His family our Father wants us to ask Him for what He already longs to give us because He loves us with an unconditional everlasting love.

Dear reader, our prayer life prepares and enables us to enter in to His presence that we may receive instruction and blessings. Beloved, sometimes we just need to come to Him and unburden our-selves and know that He will always make time for us.

Listen beloved, we cannot depend on people to make us happy. Our dreams can die quick deaths right before our eyes and relationships have a way of leaving us devastated. Our faith can find a way of fading in the face of overwhelming trials and what happens when a Christian faints?

What happens when a Christian runs out of prayer and feel like they have let God down? Beloved, people are important to God and he wants us to know that he loves us unconditionally. He wants us to know that like a mother Eagle, He can fly faster than we can fall because he foreknew us and planned our life before he spoke this world into existence.

Beloved, we can look at Lazurus as an example and discover that God's word raised him from the dead but he still had bandages and he was still bound.

Beloved, although he was raised and freed from the grave, it took others to free him from the bandages.

We want people around us that are healthy and dress like us then we are comfortable being around them but what about those in the street that are living for each day?

God's love calls us out from death and when we feel his tug on our heart we are feeling a Father's heart. Beloved when we give into that tug and allow him entrance into our life, we will discover love like we have never known.

Beloved our Heavenly Father is quick to forgive and like Hoseah buying Gomer his runaway wife back from the auction block, he is quick to forgive.

Remember when she said I will call you master, he said no you call me Ishi your husband. Father God will embrace us as his children and take away our shame and our sin with a Father's heart and a Father's love. His Glory will cover our low self-esteem and let us know that we are special to him.

Galatians 4:6 “And because you are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts crying Abba Father!”

“And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer, and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.” **(Isiah 65:24)**

James 5:13-18 (KJV) ¹³ Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

¹⁴ Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

¹⁵ And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

¹⁶ Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. (God Loves Prayer)

¹⁷ Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.

¹⁸ And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

Chapter VI

Prayers of Intercession

I really do not know where to begin to speak on this subject and give us some in-depth to just how important this special calling is to the body of Christ especially churches and ministries both large and small.

We find in God's word that Jesus while on Earth was the model intercessor and we shall speak on that later in this chapter.

I once had a lady that had become a part of our women's ministry approach me asking if she could have another position in the ministry.

This same lady had been healed of full blown aides which was not of her doing but from an unfaithful spouse. She had asked the Lord to show me her condition and soon he did one day while praying. I made it a point to travel to one of the Northern States and have special prayer with her. She was a pretty woman that had rashes and sores that had broken out on her body.

Dear ones, I was informed later that week that the living God had blessed her with her healing.

She later with a friend made a road trip to meet me in one of our ministry meetings that was being held in our church that was located in Kentucky.

There was also a truck driver from Alabama that made the meeting because God had instantly healed him of sugar diabetes. One of our ministers (actually the Pastor of the church in Kentucky) was also a driver. He had met this driver on the road and they had become good friends.

The Pastor had spoken to him about a mighty revival God allowed me to do in his church where God had created ear drums in an elderly gentleman that had been born without ear drums. Up until that revival the man had not being able to hear anything not even a sound.

This man had lived his entire life not being able to hear a sound and God without telling me of his condition instantly healed the man in front of everybody.

The testimony from the pastor caused the driver to look toward God after all divine intervention was this truck drivers only hope to keep his job and he called

me after leaving the doctor. He had failed his DOT physical which would cost him his job.

I shall never forget this call because even in a frustrated mood because of the severe trials I was going through, God moved on the scene and brought deliverance.

During our conversation, the driver informed me of his situation and his meeting with the pastor in Kentucky. The driver was from Alabama and asked if I would take time and pray for him because his results had come back that he had a severe case of sugar diabetes.

The man desired prayer and although I was very busy, I took time to pray with him over the phone and asked him to turn around and go back to the same doctor for another check because this disease would place him in a bad situation because in this stage he could no longer drive his truck for a living.

The man named Alvin later called to inform me that when I prayed for him, the wind began to blow inside his car and outside his car which got his attention. The medical examiner agreed to give him

another test and the results came back that there was no problem with sugar in his body.

This driver made the trip to Kentucky to be in our meeting and the woman that had been healed of AIDS was also there.

Both gave their testimony of the great compassionate God that had met their need.

After consulting with the lead Pastor and discovering that the man was a seasoned minister, I not only allowed him to give his testimony in that powerful meeting but the church allowed him to preach and boy did he preach!

Dear reader this is a type of intercessory prayer and the enemy tries to get people thinking that God is holding back on them but the word clearly states that it is his good pleasure to give us the mysteries of the Kingdom.

The lady that had been healed of HIV became a regular on our women's prayer line and loved the Lord with all of her heart but someone asked her what her position was in the ministry and when she informed

them that she was a prayer intercessor, they almost broke her spirit by telling her this position was not an important one in the ministry.

She approached me and asked if she could have another position which really caught me off guard for God had used me in this calling many times.

I regained my chain of thought and asked her if she had a heart?

Shaken with the question she replied yes.

I proceeded to ask her if she could see her heart to which she replied no.

I asked how do you know you have one and what is its job?

She replied because I am alive and its job is to pump the blood through my body which gives my body life. I asked her what would happen if it quits pumping the blood. She replied my body will die because the life of the body is in the blood.

I informed her that this is what her called position is in the body of Christ. Without true called prayer intercessors, the ministry would die because the

intercessors are the ones that are engaged in Spiritual warfare to combat the onslaught attacks from the enemy.

Dear reader, did you know that back in the ministries of AA Allen and William Branham, most of the church of God rejected the move of God's visitation calling it all sorts of things. Soon after this the mediums and occult moved in to fill the void and that is where we are at today.

Beloved, God is about to visit us again and we need prayer warriors we call prayer intercessors.

We can look at our Lord overlooking Jerusalem praying over them and interceding for them in His famous prayer in Matthew 23:37

Look at Jesus the Model Intercessor
Matthew 23:37-39 (KJV)

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would no.

Beloved, go with me to the 17th chapter of John where we find the Lord Interceding for the church in the garden of Gethsemane.

John 17 (KJV)

These words spoke Jesus, and lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify thee:

As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

And this is life eternal, that they might know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom Thou hast sent.

I have glorified Thee on the earth: I have finished the work which Thou gavest me to do.

And now, O Father, glorify Thou me with Thine own self with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was.

I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: Thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept hy word.

Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.

For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.

And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.

And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.

While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.

And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Dear reader this is an awesome prayer for here just before his crucifixion, we find the Lord praying for you and for me to share in his glory. He is praying for unity in the body asking God to receive us as he would him. In this setting, he is interceding and praying till his sweat became as great drops of blood. The Lord is

praying for the church to become one body functioning in harmony to his soon to be established Kingdom as can be found in Luke 22.

Dear reader, our next example of intercession is to do a study of Moses interceding for his people which can be found in Deuteronomy 9: 13-14.

Here God is willing to do away with the promise to the seed of Abraham and make a greater Nation out of Moses. We clearly see Moses in his humility pleading for God's mercy to be upon his people.

This beloved shows the heart of a true leader however the thought that always bore in my mind is how he could lead more than three and one half million people when just a few would make me want to give the job too someone else.

“Furthermore the LORD spoke unto me, saying, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiff-necked people:” “Let me alone, that I may destroy them, and blot out their name from under heaven: and I will make of thee a nation mightier and greater than they.”

“Look at Moses interceding for his people”

“Thus I fell down before the LORD” “forty days and forty nights, as I fell down at the first; because the LORD had said he would destroy you” I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

“Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin: Lest the land whence thou broughtest us out say, Because the LORD was not able to bring them into the land which he promised them, and because he hated them, he hath brought them out to slay them in the wilderness. Yet they are thy people and thine inheritance, which thou broughtest out by thy mighty power and by thy stretched out arm.

I close this chapter with some encouraging words and those words are “some people are called to be intercessors.”

The Lord spoke to me many years ago informing me that he gave Satan free reign in this world and he will honor his rights as much as he will honor ours.

Beloved, God took an oath and bound himself to his word and he will not act outside of it therefore he may need someone to pray before he can act to come to change some things especially in an emergency situation.

Dear reader, remember Moses and as long as they held his hands up the people would overcome their oppressors but when his hand fell down the enemy would prevail.

Exodus 17: 10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

13 But Moses' hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Dear reader, someone that is called to be a prayer intercessor may experience some very unusual things such as being awakened in the middle of the night including hearing a knocking noise on the wall by their bed and their partner lying beside them will hear nothing.

This is what I call God's minute men and women in the body of Christ. Like the colonists fighting for our freedom from the Tyranny of Britain were required to be ready to confront the assault of the enemy at a moment's notice this is what prayer intercessors are in the Kingdom of God.

Since we are a connected body making up the church, we too are engaged in a colossal fight and we

must be ready to do spiritual warfare to confront the many attacks and schemes of the enemy.

The good part of this is that the Lord knows them that are his and when one member suffers the scriptures state in *Corinthians 12:26* that we all feel it in one way or another.

1 Corinthians 12:26 (KJV)

²⁶ And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it.

Beloved, somebody could be in trouble here in the USA and God will speak their name for prayer to one of his prayer warriors in another country to stop what they are doing and pray maybe even waking them up in the middle of the night to pray a special prayer just for you.

How many times have we been with the wrong crowd and a praying mother or grandmother was on their knees asking God to protect their boy or grandson.

How many times have we as his children escaped a bad situation because of God having someone on a minutes notice to become burdened and pray.

I remember an instance where I was ministering and all of a sudden I had a vision of head lights coming at me.

We stopped the service and prayed only to have someone's daughter call in from the scene of the wreck.

The wreck had just happened in front of her and she called to inform her mom of the wreck that would be seen on the news but also to thank her for her prayers because it could have been her being carried out by an ambulance.

Chapter VII

Asking & Believing Prayer

Beloved, did you know that how we approach God and what we are willing to ask Him for will reflect how we view him!

Dear reader, do you view God as one that works on a merit system that requires us to satisfy some demand to gain his favor like other religions or do we approach him as a loving Father who loves his children?

Beloved, we tend sometimes to make our requests in accordance to what we understand about his character.

1. How does a child who has an abusive father approach their father?
2. What will they ask for and how will they approach them?
3. Will they be fearful that he may burst into an emotion uproar?

Dear reader, are we as God's children approaching Him with fear and do we approach Him with the thought that He is waiting for us to fail?

Beloved, God foreknew us and His desire is for us as His children to approach Him as the Model Father believing He is full of compassion and love that is determined to bring us to a good end.

James 4:2 states that “we have not because we ask not and we are expected to ask Him for the things He has promised.”

Beloved may I ask you a question?

If the God who created this world out of nothing were to hand you a blank check, how would you fill it out?

Would you use it to better yourself or would you use it to help others and advance the Kingdom of God?

One thing we must recognize is that timing is everything in the Kingdom of God.

Beloved, we must not be praying a one sided prayer but stay in his presence and allow Him time to place His burden in our heart. We must realize that He is all knowing and looking at everything and everyone around us that will be affected by our prayers.

Beloved, we need daily strength to continue this journey. What we had yesterday is not sufficient to face what we may encounter today.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (KJV)

¹³ There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that Ye may be able to bear it.

When we come before the Lord and express our needs, we need to recognize that he instructed us to ask because He is concerned. We stand with confidence knowing that our God is able to answer our prayer and meet our needs.

The Lord linked the word (and) in the phrase between asking for daily bread and asking for daily forgiveness.

Beloved I feel safe in stating that because we do not know what dangers we may encounter or what lies ahead, we need God's protection to cover and

protect us therefore we are told to pray "deliver us from evil"?

Dear reader, we as His children need to discover in His word that all temptations must have his approval before they can be sent against us. God will not allow us to be destroyed for He said He will never leave us therefore we may have trials that seem to break us but thank God we are not walking through them alone for His word stated that He is an ever present help in the time of trouble.

Let us come boldly unto God and make our request with confidence and humility remembering His word in Hebrews 11:6 that states "without faith, it is impossible to please Him".

God has extended His grace unto us that we can come boldly unto Him with praise and thanksgiving in our heart for we are His children.

Chapter VIII

Seeking His Devine Guidance

Beloved, God desires for us to have a personal intimate relationship with Him and we do this by having a conditioned prayer life.

When we seek the Lord in prayer, we are entering a higher level of intimacy such as seeking His presence and glory.

One example of this kind of prayer might be asking and seeking for direction or simply asking for His will to be done in our life instead of us asking Him to bless our will and our plans.

By entering into this realm of prayer, we are getting beyond our will and seeking His divine guidance in a situation and allowing Him complete control over it.

Jeremiah 29 verse 13 states that “if we seek him with our whole heart, we shall find Him.”

Hebrews 11 verse 6 states that “God will reward those that diligently seek Him.”

Beloved, may I remind you that we read earlier in the Lord's prayer that the disciples were learning the proper way to pray and were told to not pray out loud in public but to enter their closet and shut the door.

God cannot place things in our hand until He first prepares our heart to receive and know that He can trust us with the answer! Beloved, God is doing a work in us and conforming us by His Spirit to become the image of His dear Son. There is a work of regeneration in us taking place and God desires for us to become a part of Him and the plan He has for all of us.

Beloved, we need to seek our Heavenly Father for wise council, be an influence to the world around us and not allow the world to influence us.

The Lord Himself told us to seek first the Kingdom of heaven and all these other things will be added unto us however our blessings and needs should never take precedence to seeking the King.

Beloved, the enemy is showing his face now more than ever and we are in a battle that is hot and wicked. This battle requires for us to be alert, and ready at all times to give a word to the weary and to those in need.

Beloved, this walk of faith requires a strong prayer life and prayer sometimes needs fasting for its perfect development. Fasting helps to cleanse our body of unwanted toxins however, fasting with sincere

prayer prepares our Spirit man to be strengthened for as the flesh gets weaker the Spirit man is able to receive instructions from the Lord.

Authors Note: "Some readers have complained about my inserting scripture in my books. Beloved, the word is anointed and some people may not ever read their bibles but will read the word in a book."

Isaiah 58 states that "this kind of fasting will give us fresh revelation and our soul shall be like a watered garden."

Verse 6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

Verse 7 Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

Verse 8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy re-reward.

Verse 9 Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am. If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity;

Verse 10 And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

Verse 11 And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Verse 12 And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, the repairer of the breach, the restorer of paths to dwell in.

Verse 13 If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and

call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words:

14 Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it.

Chapter IX

Knocking Gains Access

Matthew 7:7-8 (KJV)

⁷ Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

⁸ For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Saints, we are nearing the end of this study and it has taken much prayer to give you the reader an idea of why the writer used knocking in the last part of verse eight. I believe I have a good revelation of what the writer is speaking of especially when you study the parable of the unjust judge as found in Luke the 18th chapter.

As you read this parable try to picture this widow woman in your mind approaching this heathen judge and then remember that the widows had no rights before the courts in those days, however wealthy people could get their case heard by bribing the court and slipping money under the table.

Luke 18:1-8 (KJV)

¹⁸ And He spoke a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

² There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:

- ³ And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary.
- ⁴ And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;
- ⁵ Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.
- ⁶ And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.
- ⁷ And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?
- ⁸ I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?

Beloved, here is a woman of Israel the seed of Abraham that is supposed to be blessed but in this parable she is a widow with no male to represent her in the courts and she is faced with an adversary (probably someone) who wanted to take advantage of her.

Some scholars think it was connected to her land taxes which involved the need for her sons to till the ground and raise the crops.

In this parable she has no representative nor is she able to pay money under the table to even get her case heard which was known to take place in those days.

The woman takes her need to God!

The woman in this parable understands that widows living in this era of time have no rights and she has no one to turn to except God. Moses stated to not forget the rights of the widows and strangers but Israel is not practicing it in this day for they had no rights.

In my spirit I can see this woman push back some food and take this to God for the God of Israel has been known to bless her forefathers.

The Lord emphasizes in this parable that the woman has to approach an unjust judge as Jesus said, a judge who feared not God nor regarded man but she also knows she is under the blessing of Abraham.

Beloved, knowing God like I do and having Him deliver me in uncontrollable circumstances allows me to picture this parable like a play in a theater.

Let us reflect back and review how we covered the part of Ask and ye shall receive, then the Lord got a little more directive as one might use the word aggressive which speaks of the second part of asking which is Seek and ye shall find.

Now we get elevated into a place where he gets more aggressive when he says that when we knock it shall be opened unto us. May I ask for you dear reader to stop and think of the many things that can be opened unto us when we persevere in our prayer Life?

Ephesians. 3: 20

²⁰ Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.

This scripture gives us some hope in knowing that our God is more than able to meet our needs even when things look hopeless and impossible. Let us also remember that what is impossible with man is possible with our God. The Lord Himself stated that “what is

impossible with man is possible with God for with Him, All things are possible.” Matthew 19:26.

Go with me as this widow woman gets away into solitude from any interference and begins to consecrate herself to the Lord her God.

In this setting, I can see her reminding God of his promises and her dependence upon him. She might have read the prayer of Jehoshaphat to him when he reminded God of his promises and how the enemy has ganged up on him to take away his inheritance. Maybe like him, she spoke of her hopelessness and that her eyes was upon him the God of Israel.

Look at her now, she visits the court trusting in her God and she finally gets her case heard to avenge her of her adversary to which the rough reply was no but this did not stop her. She leaves the court and goes to her solitude with her king.

Beloved, maybe others have out of concern asked if anyone had seen her but she is in deep prayer and consecration. This woman is now full of faith and is on her way back to the court.

By this time the judge is impressed by her perseverance and is actually looking for her to come before him. Maybe he even made mention to some of the staff working in the court that at a certain time the widow woman will come before him and he will say no.

To this stern judge this is out of the norm and starting to become a game maybe exciting at first but soon begins to take its toll especially when he starts to see the woman coming before him in his sleep.

Her God is working behind the scenes and finally she has his peace in her heart.

She has prayed through and entered the throne of the Judge of the Universe who sends the Angel of peace to comfort her.

Dear reader, I have some very good friends that are known as the Browder's and they wrote a song sometime back titled "Put it in God's Hands" It goes on to say "He knows what to do and he is never too busy to care for you"

Look dear ones as this widow woman is now full of faith as she enters his court room and the presence of her God is changing the atmosphere in the whole court.

Beloved Jesus stated in his parable that the unjust judge gives in to the woman's petition and grants her request then he gives us a picture of the heart of God as he closes with the exclamation that God will avenge his elect that cry unto him day and night.

"The Lord also exclaims that he will avenge them speedily."

Beloved, the enemy is not called the trickster by the Indians for nothing because he is the master deceiver. Just like he used the same strategy to tempt Eve in the garden, he tries to trick people into thinking God is holding back on them when in reality God states in his word that his desire is to give us the Kingdom including its many mysteries.

The word states that all creation is in moaning for the manifestation of the Sons of God.

Beloved, do you not think it is time for us to realize that we are more than flesh and blood?

Dear reader, we are more than what we see under an x-ray machine.

We are eternal spirits inhabiting a fleshly body but wait, we are more than that for we are a purchased possession for we were bought with a high price and that price was the sinless Son of God becoming our sin substitute that we may be redeemed!

Chapter X

How to Enter His Presence

Dear reader, I thought I was finished with this study however I was prompted by God's sweet Holy Spirit to add this chapter on how to enter in to the throne. I have found in my many revivals and solitudes with God that this special door must be opened by his

Spirit. I have also discovered that our relationship with Him is through and by His wonderful Spirit.

As we spend time in fasting and prayer, we will develop a special bond with His Spirit. In His time and the perseverance of our prayer we will find that there are different levels that we attain as we keep focused and open to that inner voice. We will discover that the atmosphere around us will change and there will be portals open to God's throne that we do not reach with ordinary prayer.

The Holy Spirit will not glorify Himself but will always lift up and glorify Jesus. God's Spirit revealed to me that God was in Christ reconciling (reconsolidating the debt to one or you can say recolonizing the planet with his glory) the world back to himself.

God's Spirit will honor Jesus because he is the one promised to not only redeem mankind but actually he was the other Adam with a soul and spirit just like you and me.

God's Spirit is our partner and guide that is armed with the predestined plan God has for us to fulfill His work of regeneration in us.

The Holy Spirit is the one that will introduce the Father and Son to us even opening the door for us to have direct communication with them.

This is awesome for many times down through the years in sincere prayer, I have had special visions from my Father and believe me you will know the difference.

Saints, I hope you have enjoyed the valuable insights in the previous chapters but now it is time to discover the secret to dwelling and abiding in that most holy place where only a few have arrived.

We start by studying the First and Third chapters of the book of Ephesians where we will find the Apostle Paul praying for the Ephesian people the most important prayer that a person can pray for another believer. He is praying that God would take these people deeper and deeper into an intimate knowledge of who He is.

We all know there are several names of God and each one defines His character and I strongly suggest that you do a study on his names and you will like me be in full adoration of who He is.

We find in *Exodus 19:18* that Mount Sinai was covered with smoke because the Lord descended upon it with fire. The smoke billowed up from it like smoke from a furnace, and the whole mountain trembled violently. The people heard the sound of a trumpet sounding loud and increasing in volume followed by a voice proclaiming His name and proclaiming His glory. There is something in these scriptures that stood out to me that showed the relationship Moses had with God. Saints, the word says that Moses spoke and God answered him by a voice.

Paul in the First Chapter of Ephesians is praying and asking God to grant a prayer to the Ephesians that only the Holy Spirit is able to give.

We find in Chapter Two and verse 18 that we have access to God by His Spirit. Notice, Paul is not asking for more strength, more motivation or more determination for these men but for them to be endued with Spiritual Wisdom and Revelation that would bring

them to a greater understanding and revelation of the Knowledge of God.

Beloved, as we look at the First Chapter and starting at the 17th verse we find the prayer prayed by the Apostle Paul for these Ephesian people.

I want to emphasize that when we pray this prayer by praying these scriptures mentioned above that we are praying a prayer that God recognizes.

Are you hungry for that deeper walk and seek for that intimate relationship with the living God, then may I strongly suggest you to do a study of the life of King David and find out what real worship is all about.

True worship begins when we see our Lord for who He is, catch a glimpse of His holiness. It is how we esteem (Value) (Admire) Him for who He is.

We worship God in our heart as we enter into his rest trusting that he that foreknew us has a divine plan and purpose for our life.

We praise Him with our voice to vent out the worship that is filling our heart. I want you to know that there is power unleashed when we enter into true worship and praise.

When we reach this level in God is when we enter into his rest because in this place, we have come to a place of total surrender given him complete authority in our lives.

True worship from the heart can be likened to total surrender to his will and plan for our life. We are honoring him as our Lord and King which causes us to enter into his rest knowing he is in complete control of everything that pertains to us.

Hebrews 4:9-10

⁹ There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.

¹⁰ For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

Dear reader, did you know that the rest God speaks about in his word comes through worship! As we studied before, there is a difference in Praise and worship or in plain speech, Praise is not anywhere near worship. Praise is thinking him for who he is and what he has done but worship is seeing him in his magnificent power and glory knowing he has a plan and purpose for your life and worship is when you fall before him in total surrender to that predestined will and

purpose. There is a rest in God where burdens that are attempting to hold us captive, lose the power of their grasp as we get our eyes and focus on Him who loves us and gave Himself for us.

Saints it is time to seek His face like never before and enter in to what I like to call the fifth dimension which is the place that God dwells where time and space are not governed by the law of physics that govern this planet.

It is a place where spiritual law will and can override natural law and I intend to get into some of my experiences God allowed me to experiment in this realm in a later chapter.

Beloved, solitude is the key to hearing God's voice in knowing Him and preaching His Word with an anointing that will break the grasp the powers of darkness have on the people.

Jesus said that when we pray, we are to enter our closets in private and it is in that private place that Satan is restricted and cannot hear our prayers because we are covered by the shield of His love.

Church, it is time to get past the sanctuary of worship and enter in to a wonderful relationship with Christ who is not flesh and blood but an Eternal Being.

Beloved, things here are only temporal and last only for a season but our God is from everlasting till everlasting and nothing should ever be allowed to take the place of being in His presence.

Saints, there should never be a question in our mind when it comes to our relationship with Him. People places and things, including family, are temporal and will come to an end but our place of being in direct relationship with Him will determine how much He can trust us with in the world to come.

Saints, we need to come into a place of holy reverence for who He is and what He has done for us that we might be called sons and daughters of the most high God.

We have got to get past regular worship which is filled with man-made forms and agendas which exemplify the flesh more than the Creator.

I am talking about when the church gathering becomes more than good meetings and good preaching.

Beloved, it is when we get tired of church in the norm and the world being able to sit comfortably in our meetings and there is no conviction of their sin and way of life.

When we enter in and seek His presence with our whole heart, we are guaranteed by His word that He shall be found.

Proverbs 25 verse 25 says “As cold water is to a thirsty soul, so is good news from a far country.”

The problem today is people want a neat religion that they can control from their comfort zone but saints when the real cleansing fire of God falls, it will set the atmosphere and unmask the false, lift Christ up as Lord and reveal to us that what people thought was spirit was nothing more than their worked up flesh.

With that said, I will now reveal the intimate secret the Lord showed me that will gain access to the Father.

It is a prayer in Ephesians that the Holy Spirit prayed through the Apostle Paul for the Christians at Ephesus to have a deeper relationship with God.

Beloved, no one outside of Christ can pray this prayer and I now ask you dear reader, are you hungry for more of God?

Beloved, if you are ready to develop that special prayer time and pray these scriptures every day in your prayer time. I strongly suggest you memorize these powerful scriptures and get them in your spirit man.

I conditioned myself some years back to memorize and pray these scriptures every time I had a spare moment on my hands.

I would catch myself quoting and praying these scriptures while driving my 18 wheeler late at night and usually around 3 am. I found that most demonic activity has calmed down at that time of the morning.

Dear reader are you ready to go further?

Let us now turn to the Third Chapter of

Ephesians and start at the 1st verse.

Here we find the Apostle Paul launching deeper in this prayer and thanking God for who He is in a spirit of worship. He then asks God to grant unto them to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man that they might know the unfathomable Love of Christ.

Here Paul is praying for the spiritual growth and well-being of these Ephesians that they might know the length, the depth, and the height of God's love shown to us through the giving of His son to suffer our penalty of death and by raising Him up for our justification that we may become sons and daughters of the most high God. When we become sons and daughters and have received the spirit of adoption into His royal family, then this prayer states that there is nothing that we can think of that he is not able to bring to pass.

The bottom line is that God will honor this prayer and the Christian Life has God's Mercy as its foundation.

Beloved, most all songs, praise, prayers, communion services, preaching and our giving reflects upon the mercy of God that is clearly seen in Jesus Christ the Son.

Dear reader, because of His mercy, my whole life that was upside down and empty of meaning is now one of worship and adoration for this wonderful God whom I call my friend.

Saints, There is nothing the church needs more today than a fresh encounter with the holiness and presence of the living God.

Men and women have made attempts to bring God down to their level and lower His standard and requirements for living but when His presence and holiness is introduced to us by His Spirit then we find and discover that He is the Standard and has called all men and women unto repentance.

The scriptures reveal that great men of God trembled and fell on their faces when they found themselves in the presence of the holy Angels and we can only imagine what it will be like to meet this awesome Eternal being one day and give an account of our lives.

This Awesome Creator has extended unto each of us an invitation to accept His pardon and His grace through the finished work of his son Jesus Christ in

giving his life as a ransom for all that receive His pardon and forgiveness.

What a joy in knowing that we have received the Spirit of His Son into our hearts making us Sons, Daughters, and Heirs of His royal family.

This Awesome God is calling us to come out of the outer court of the sanctuary and into the inner court of His presence and grace.

Christ has offered to share His Glory and His throne with His people for the scriptures state that one day we shall judge Angels.

When we dwell in this intimate place, the powers of darkness cannot pervade for it is our private time of knowing God and experiencing Him in a way that can only be described as complete intimacy.

I love to tell people that approach me concerning my walk with Christ and the high anointing on my life that they can go drink from the same fountain that I drink from and that is the fresh, clear water of the Holy Spirit by spending time with Him in solitude.

Do you want to see the beauty, and the splendor and the glory and the majesty of God then look unto Jesus!

Beloved, Jesus is superior to the Holy Angels and he is far superior to Moses, the great leader, the greatest prophet to arise in all of Israel. Beloved, Jesus is greater than all of the prophets for He is more than a great prophet.

Jesus is God in human flesh. He is greater than Israel's high priest for He is the ultimate High Priest, the One who would go into the Holy Place once and for all to pay the price and give the sacrifice.

God did not make a covenant with mortal man conceived in sin that would not be able to keep it but made an everlasting covenant with His Son and when we accept His plan of salvation we are drafted into that covenant as sons and daughters of the Most High God.

The new covenant God made with his Son is an everlasting covenant and is better than the old covenant because it provides a remedy for sin.

When Jesus shed His blood on that cross two thousand years ago, it was not something that had to

be repeated over and over again like the shedding of the blood of goats and bulls and sheep or any other animal.

When David realized his mistake in attempting to bring the ark back home to Jerusalem which caused a man to lose his life, he called for the law to be read concerning the handling of the ark. After studying the law he sent for the priests to offer a sacrifice of blood every few steps taken and left a blood trail all the way to Jerusalem.

Beloved, Christ's blood was shed in seven places and is like no other blood that flowed on the face of this planet.

God made a covenant with His eternal blood so that you and I once and for all could be forgiven. By this covenant, He says in Hebrews chapter 10, "Let us draw near" into that holy place".

You and I have been given access into the very holy of holies because a High Priest has gone in and offered Himself as a sacrifice for our sins. Thanks to Jesus, you and I can now come into the presence of a Holy God.

Jesus did not do away with the law which was like a doctor diagnosing our problem but fulfilled its requirements to pay our sin debt and bridge the gap between us and God. The law was then put aside as a requirement for sin which could never be a permanent solution to man's sin problem.

Beloved, God raised Jesus up for our justification and through faith in Him and His finished work; we can become the children of the Living God. God has given us something to pursue, a dream to pursue.

Hebrews 12:14

"Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord".

Dear reader, may I take time in this study and ask some very important questions related to our Christian life?

1. What is the purpose?
2. What is it we are pursuing?
3. Peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.

Beloved, we define holiness as something just for us, but as we study the history of great revivals when the holiness of God comes we find that people are broken in humility.

What happens is that nothing is hid and peace is made between brothers and sisters in Christ.

All the barriers that have been erected by man and by Satan and by the flesh are torn down.

Racial barriers, denominational barriers, barriers of broken fellowship, past hurts and pain are torn down when we get in the pursuit of peace with all men and the pursuit of holiness. God is righteous and we need to have the same desires that He has.

Beloved, when something is wicked before us, we need to call it what it is and when something is pure and holy before us, we need to hold on to it and have a burning desire for it.

Our passion, desire, and hunger should be on the things that are pleasing to God.

1. Are we hungry?

2. Do we have a strong desire for God to control our lives

Dear reader, we need to spend time in God's word and presence, kneeling before Him and meeting with Him.

God wants to revitalize and renew us but if we do not maintain a prayer life and make that a regular part of our Christian walk, we will not be able to cope with all the trials and tests that are sure to come our way. Church, the desire for God and His righteousness should be a driving force in our lives.

Jesus said that we are to go into our closets in private and it is in that private place we are to pray unto the Lord and that is the hidden place where Satan cannot hear our prayers where we are covered by the shield of His love.

When we dwell in this secret place, the powers of darkness cannot pervade for it is our private time of knowing God and experiencing Him in intimacy that we drink the wine of Christ and experience the life that He purchased for us as new creations through the blood of His atoning sacrifice.

Dear reader, we are formed and held there in the secret place where God's mercy meets God's judgment and together we were formed before the foundations of the world by the palm of an all-knowing God who loves us and ransomed us through His sacrifice.

Beloved, we can experience liberation from the powers of darkness and the anointing of the Lord will fill us to the overflowing nature of the everlasting glory of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

When we abide in the secret place we are hidden from the enemy and the enemy cannot touch us therefore in that secret place where we are hidden from the enemy the forces of darkness cannot prevail against us so therefore we can pray in the power of the Holy Spirit without fear because God has given us a sound mind and strength to pray in the power of His Spirit.

Praying in the Spirit is allowing the Holy Spirit to direct our prayer which will raise up a powerful defense to defeat the powers of darkness.

Saints, this takes place in the spirit realm through the anointing and indwelling presence of Christ within us who gives us strength to be an overcomer.

We can use an illustration of placing our hand in a glove. By itself, the glove can do nothing but when we place our hand in it then it not only has a living substance in it but it also has the strength of the life that is in it.

Because we have been redeemed, Christ is now dwelling inside us and we not only have the power of attorney to act in His name but we have the strength of that power within (Christ in me; the hope of glory) which causes us to declare that we can do all things through Christ that strengthens us.

Chapter XI

Samples of Answered Prayer

The man of God used in the 1949 Hebrides revival related an account of the days leading up to the revival.

It was during the week-night prayer meeting that God visited the church in a mighty way.

There had been bitter opposition to the Gospel in the village, and although many attended the meetings from other areas, very few locals attended.

A church leader suggested they should go to prayer, and thirty or so moved into the home of a friendly farmer.

Prayer was hard, and about midnight Duncan Campbell turned to the local blacksmith who had been silent so far and said, 'I feel the time has come when you ought to pray.'

The man prayed for about half an hour, because in revival, time doesn't matter, and then drew his prayer to a close with a bold challenge?

"God I am asking you to realize that your honor is at stake?" "God in your word you promised to pour floods on dry ground, and you are not doing it." He paused for a while and then concluded stating, "God again I state that your honor is at stake, and I challenge You to keep Your covenant promises."

Without warning the granite house where they were gathered began to shake like a leaf.

One elder thought it was an earth tremor? Duncan Campbell stated that he was reminded of Acts 4:31: 'After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken'.

The Evangelist pronounced the benediction and everyone went outside.

It was about two o'clock in the morning and they found the whole village alive, ablaze with God.

Men and women were carrying chairs and asking if there was room in the church for them!

Saints, we must prepare ourselves for true revival. Preparation for revival comes when we allow God to work in us to bring us to a place of repentance and a new walk of obedience to the Lord.

If we have a desire to get to know God, we must get to know Him in His sovereignty, that He is Almighty God. We must know Him as the sovereign God, the sovereign majesty.

Psalm 66:18 "If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me."

Titus 2:11-14 says, "For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared unto all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ; Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works."

Beloved I pray that you have enjoyed this study Seminar on "The Magnified Power of Prayer" and in closing, I took the liberty to list for you the four necessity's to get your prayers answered and have guaranteed revival. Remember, God loves people and they are important to him. Devoted prayer brings revival and it must begin in us.

1. True Revival is God in His holiness doing a work among His people and it requires a price.

2. Revival is not Evangelism and not proclaiming the Gospel to those who do not know Christ.
3. True Revival is God renewing our hearts.
4. True Revival must begin in us in spending time in prayer and his word allowing his Holy Spirit to grant us entrance into a spirit of worship which is God's rest. Beloved this is when God will inhabit the praises of his people and will make himself known.

Chapter XII

Prayer in the Fifth Dimension

I do not know where to begin with this chapter as it will be beyond anyone believing it could occur. I titled this chapter the fifth dimension because I believe it is the time and the season for the supernatural. The Wikipedia states that "the fifth dimension is a space with 5 dimensions or the fourth dimension of time used in relativity physics." Einstein taught on time and physics. It has to do with us becoming aware that God

placed no limits or boundaries concerning how far we may go in the Spirit.

The prophet Ezekiel in Ezekiel Chapter 47 verse 5 speaks of the depths of the Spirit as being a river that no man can pass over. God is not bound or confined by the laws that govern this planet and sometimes He allows His greatest creation to cross into a spiritual realm where the Spiritual law will override the natural law. It is as though time sometimes seems as if it is standing still and the laws and elements set in place to govern this planet must give way to God and His word operating through His chosen vessel in this realm. I am speaking about supernatural events and happenings that I have witnessed in my own life and ministry.

It all started when I was barely ten years old as I was attempting to read my Bible in the place that my late grandfather had used in his sermon at the Methodist church. I was reading in the book of Revelation concerning the city that sits upon the seven mountains. I had no sooner read it that a voice spoke out in the room and said. "That is Rome Italy?" I became frightened not knowing who or what was in the room with me. I started paying more attention to my

granddad's sermons and developed a keen interest in God's word. I wanted to learn more about a Creator that was so interested in me. I would steal away by myself and ask Him to reveal Himself to me and tell Him that I wanted to meet him. It was not long till I had an encounter that scared me so bad I gave up on wanting to meet Him.

One night in my room I had my Bible open and it was as if a man was wetting his finger to turn the pages and they started turning like this without anyone near the Bible. I became frightened and begged the unseen fingers to stop and it did for a long time.

Later in my adult years, God began to use me in healing and the supernatural.

I remember one occasion somewhere in the mountains of Virginia this unseen hand showing up again. A local pastor there and his son in law had asked me to accompany them to an old run down church in the mountains to pray. The church was not in good shape and I noticed a hornet's nest on the church corner.

During this time, I was praying up to four and five hours a night while driving my eighteen wheeler. This nest was about eye level and I knew the son-in-law needed an encounter with God. I felt led to walk over and look at these creatures of God sitting on their nest. I walked over and looked at them up close and they never offered to move. I felt led to pray and we dropped to our knees in prayer. I remember quoting some scripture from the ground.

By the time we stood on our feet the wind had increased and I begin to relate to these ministers how God had actually turned the pages in my Bible several times in my life and wondered if He would do it in front of them.

Suddenly, the wind began to turn the pages in my Bible but what really got my attention is when they stopped turning when they reached the placed in the scriptures that I had quoted while in prayer. Saints, I do not believe that this book would hold all the stories and occasions God has used me in the other realm.

Once, an eye doctor informed me that all his test results point to the fact that Glaucoma had started to take root in my eyes. Saints, I got mad and preached

out of his office even ending up in his waiting room saying, "No doctor, that is only a delusion and that mess does not exist in my body because I do not live or operate in the fallen kingdom through the fall of Adam. I live and operate in the established kingdom of God claiming the victory of the covenant God made with His son.

Well, the good doctor asked me to calm down and show up the next morning at his other office located in the hospital and he would run the same tests there but he also informed me he thought it was a waste of time and money.

I made a few phone calls but knowing and reflecting on the mighty miracle services where the presence of God moved to do mighty healings I knew in my Spirit that God was up to something.

Saints, I showed up the next morning and allowed the doctor to run his tests.

At the conclusion of his findings, the good young doctor came in and sit beside me. He said, "Jerry, I do not understand what is going on but all I can say is that

whatever was showing up yesterday is not there today."

Saints, what if I had allowed the results of the first test to influence my thinking? The enemy would have had a field day with me diminishing my faith but again, I am not moved by what I see but by what the Spirit of God has to say within me through His word.

I suffered some tremendous losses and endured many trials even losing my earthly father and later my own mom who was killed in an automobile accident. It was during this time I also was in an accident in my eighteen wheeler with a young mother using the side of my trailer to take her own life.

Beloved, this and many more trials including divorce came my way all within three years' time but let me tell you that God was right by my side through it all. He later brought me out with an anointing and unshakable faith.

I did not want to place this in this book but we just need to hold on to our faith and not allow the pressures of life on the outside get on the inside. It was during this time that alarms would be activated if I

showed up after hours in businesses, including several Walmart's in located in different cities.

One time when I was a young preacher, one of my old mentors had died and I often would visit his grave in a lonely countryside to be alone with God.

I remember on one occasion that I was disturbed about some things and visited this man of God's grave. The grave was located on a hillside a good distance from a nearby church.

I crossed the field and entered the bottom of the graveyard and decided to pray. I began to relate to God how this man had been used by Him to touch my life and that I missed him terribly.

Suddenly, I heard a noise in the nearby woods and noticed a small twisting wind tunnel was making its way out of the woods bringing leaves and twisting them in a circle. As if guided by an unseen hand, the wind tunnel made its way across the graveyard and stopped on top of the man of God's grave. It stayed there for a few minutes and I felt the urge to open my Bible. It opened to Paul speaking in 2 Corinthians chapter 12 verses 2 and 3 concerning a man being called up into

the third heaven. God was informing me that this man of God was with Him and I had all I need to finish my course.

You, dear Saint, will be the one with new ideas and able to solve problems that will arise because of the one that lives within you who knows the end from the beginning.

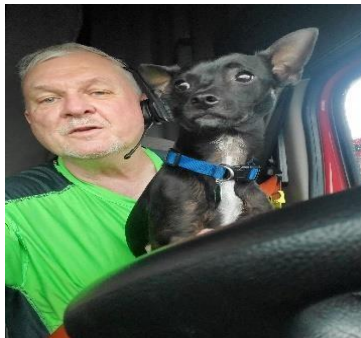
The bottom line is that it is the deep placed within me calling unto the deep riches of His glory and with that said we will close this chapter with a shout of thankfulness and a big A-Men!
