## The Roman Road to Salvation

1. (Romans 3: 10) "As it is written, there is none righteous, no, not one.
2. (Romans 3:23) "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God"
3. (Romans 6:23) "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
4. (Romans 5:8) "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. "
5. (Romans 5:1-2) (1) "Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ;" (2) By whom also we have access by faith into this grace in wherein we now stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."
6. (Romans 10:9-13) (9) "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (10) "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." (11) "For the scripture saith, whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed." (12) "For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him." (13) "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."
7. (Romans 1:16) "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek."
